Parents and PAA staff breathed a collective sigh of relief when all of our students returned home from their mission trips. Everyone was safe, healthy, and this year we had no cyclones or hurricanes to contend with. It was another impactful year!

Students served as far as Fiji and the Bahamas and two other groups also served the many needs in our own hometown.

For 10 years, our work in Fiji with the Jabez Humanitarian Foundation (www.jabezhf.org) has made significant progress on health clinics, water safety education, and building important infrastructure that supports the islanders with technology and clean drinking water.

Hoodview Church worked alongside our students for the second year in a row building a Tiny Home for Dignity Village, a city sanctioned homeless community.
