

Bike Ride on the Banks-Vernonia State Trail!

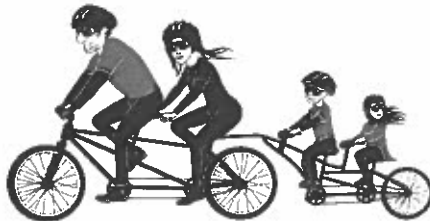
Join your social committee for a bike ride today on the beautiful Banks-Vernonia State Trail!

When: TODAY!

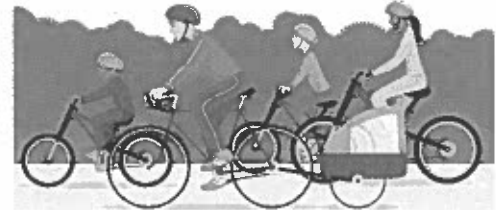
Time: Meet at the church @ 2:00 pm if you'd like to carpool

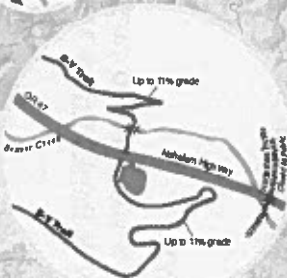

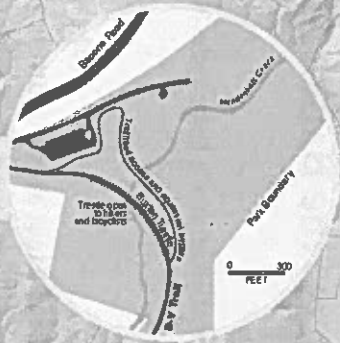
