- 1. Church Office Hours-** During this time of social distancing and cancelled services, our church secretary will be working remotely from home unless needed physically at the church. E-mail and voicemail are still options for communication. This may change from week to week depending on church needs and government regulations.
- 2. Church App Launch!** The new Beaverton Adventist Church app is now available for either IOS or Android smart phones. Please download it now to join what will quickly become our main way to communicate to the church family. The easiest way is take your smart phone and go to either our church website or main Facebook page and click the links provided. **IMPORTANT:** When prompted to accept notifications, we strongly urge you to **ALLOW** notifications. One of the main goals of this app is to keep you notified of church communications.
- 3. 19 Minutes of Prayer for 19 Days (Now its 12 days!)** Pastor Rodney wants to invite you to pray for at least 19 minutes a day about the Covid19 pandemic. No rules, no schedules, just inviting united prayer. The impact of this pandemic is massive.
