- 1. Services & Sabbath School-** At this time, we will continue holding services exclusively through our church Live Stream at beavertonsda.com. Sabbath School resources are available through the Hope Channel and Grace Link.
- 2. Called to Grow, Phase II Begins!** As of next Monday, April 13, our Phase II project begins. This is an ideal time to get started because the church is essentially vacant. A small crew of less than 10 workers will begin working on the Fellowship Hall, Upper Hallway including the offices, bathrooms and various closets. All of this is within the Covid 19 social distancing and essential services guidelines. The work crew have the proper permissions and paperwork and are expected to adhere to state expectations for coronavirus safety protocols. Praise God that the church is able to press forward and that we are able to provide employment for a small team of great workers.
- 3. Church Office Hours-** During this time of social distancing and cancelled services, our church secretary will be working remotely from home unless needed physically at the church. E-mail and voicemail are still options for communication. This may change from week to week depending on church needs and government regulations.
