- 1. Services & Sabbath School-** At this time, we will continue holding services exclusively through our church Live Stream at beavertonsda.com. Sabbath School resources are available through the Hope Channel and Grace Link on YouTube.
- 2. Called to Grow, Phase II Begins!** On Monday, April 13, our Phase II project began. This is an ideal time to get started because the church is essentially vacant. A small crew of less than 10 workers will begin working on the Fellowship Hall, Upper Hallway including the offices, bathrooms and various closets. All of this is within the Covid 19 social distancing and essential services guidelines. The work crew have the proper permissions and paperwork and are expected to adhere to state expectations for coronavirus safety protocols. Praise God that the church is able to press forward and that we are able to provide employment for a small team of great workers.
- 3. Church Office Hours-** During this time of social distancing and cancelled services, our church secretary will be working remotely from home unless needed physically at the church. E-mail and voicemail are still options for communication.
- 4. Church App Launch!** The new Beaverton Adventist Church app is now available for either IOS or Android smart phones. Please download it now to join what will quickly become our main way to communicate to the church family. The easiest way is take your smart phone and go to either our church website or main Facebook page and click the links provided. **IMPORTANT:** When prompted to accept notifications, we strongly urge you to ALLOW notifications. One of the main goals of this app is to keep you notified of church communications.

If you income has not been affected by this pandemic and your financial security is stable consider helping those who have been financially negatively affected.
