- 1. Services & Sabbath School-** At this time, we will continue holding services exclusively through our church Live Stream at beavertonsda.com. Sabbath School resources are available through the Hope Channel and Grace Link on YouTube.
- 2. CTG, Phase II Progress!** Nearly a month ago we began the long planned, Phase II remodeling project and it has gone very well. The upstairs hallway, offices, closets, and fellowship hall are scheduled to be completed by the first week of June! Our financing process is underway and set for approval very soon! We are fortunate that the NPUC Revolving Fund have lowered their interest rates by a half a percentage point. Finally, Shearer and Associates, our general contractor, have been able to adjust their schedule to press forward with the remainder of the remodeling. This means they will now move the project into the foyer and sanctuary areas! This is a blessing of timing and we are grateful.
- 3. Beaverton Adventist Church App** The app is quickly moving towards being our main way to communicate with the church community. We have been hearing great feedback from those who are interacting with it and we value the suggestions and affirmations. - 4. When can we come back together for worship?** The short answer is that we don't know yet. The 'Stay at Home' orders by the state of Oregon do not have an end date set. In fact, they are in place "until terminated by the governor" according to official statements. So, when the state clarifies the Oregon Conference of SDA leadership will evaluate and give guidance. Until that time we are grateful to have virtual connection. We look forward to coming back together and depending on the CTG Phase II progression we may come back to worship in a newly remodeled fellowship hall!
