- 2. CTG, Phase II Progress!** Nearly a month ago we began the long planned, Phase II remodeling project and it has gone very well. The upstairs hallway, offices, closets, and fellowship hall are scheduled to be completed by the first week of June! **The approval process for our loan as been completed and our loan application was approved on May 20 so our funds will be available as soon as the documents have signed.** Finally, Shearer and Associates, our general contractor, have been able to adjust their schedule to press forward with the remainder of the remodeling. This means they will now move the project into the foyer and sanctuary areas! This is a blessing of timing and we are grateful.
- 3. Beaverton Adventist Church App** The app is quickly moving towards being our main way to communicate with the church community. - 5. Re-Opening Church?** We don't know yet. Some churches are beginning to open but as of right now we don't have a date. We are tied to the phases of re-opening of the State of Oregon, Washington County and the City of Beaverton. Whenever the number allowed begins make sense for us to re-open, our church leadership will need to decided if its the right time for our congregation. When we do re-open we will need to implement rather complicated and comprehensive guidelines as set forth by the Oregon Conference. These guidelines restrict meetings times, enforce social distancing and require significant cleaning all in order to protect our community. Bottom line: be patient. It could still be quite some time before we are truly able to come back together.
