Following the new children's church at 10:50a the stream will move to the worship prelude and scrolling announcement followed by our shared worship service at **11:00am**. That means that **church begins 30 minutes early** for the next few months while we find ourselves in this current stay-at-home scenario.

- 6. Vacation Bible School-** As with many things these days due to the Covid situation we have had to alter our plans regarding VBS this year. The Oregon Conference decided to use the program we had planned this year for VBS for the Oregon Conference Camp Meeting kids program (more on that later). Therefore we will hold off doing that program ourselves until another time. Additionally the Oregon Conference is partnering with the NAD and the Texas Conference to do a Virtual Heroes, family-friendly VBS. We will be utilizing their efforts and partnering with this initiative to provide our community with a unique VBS program. Exact dates and details as to how you can participate with VBS are soon to come.
- 7. CTG, Phase II Progress!** We are fully engaged and making great progress with our shared remodeling project. One of the 'silver linings' of not being able to meet together is that it has allowed us to move efficiently with this project. We are nearly done with the fellowship hall and upper hallway. We are now moving into the foyer, sanctuary, behind the sanctuary and eventually to the down stairs bathrooms. This past week the loan application process was completed and will shortly be funded. Even while the church feels 'shut down' there is a flurry of activity happening! Thank you for support and just remember that at this time every dollar given to Called To Grow is one less dollar that will be drawn for financing.
- 8. Beaverton Adventist Church App** The app is quickly moving towards being our main way to communicate with the church community. - 9. Re-Opening Church?** We don't know yet. Some churches are beginning to open but as of right now we don't have a date. We are tied to the phases of re-opening of the State of Oregon, Washington County and the City of Beaverton. Whenever the number allowed begins make sense for us to re-open, our church leadership will need to decide if it's the right time for our congregation. When we do re-open we will need to implement rather complicated and comprehensive guidelines as set forth by the Oregon Conference. These guidelines restrict meeting times, enforce social distancing and require significant cleaning all in order to protect our community. Bottom line: be patient. It could still be quite some time before we are truly able to come back together.
