That means that **church begins 30 minutes early** for the next few months while we find ourselves in this current stay-at-home scenario.

- 9. CTG, Phase II Progress!** We are fully engaged and making great progress with our shared remodeling project. One of the 'silver linings' of not being able to meet together is that it has allowed us to move efficiently with this project. We are on the verge of having the upper hallway, bathrooms, offices, and fellowship hall fully complete and permitted for regular use! The sanctuary, foyer, behind the platform and downstairs bathrooms have been stripped down and are already being put back together. Pray for the project and we seek to be good stewards of our place of church community. - 11. Re-Opening Church?** We don't know yet but some information is starting to give us an idea. We will not be able to re-open on any meaningful level until Washington County enters Phase II of the Oregon re-opening process. However, the state has now tied Washington County's progress with Multnomah and Clackamas Counties. This means that all three counties will have to meet criteria to move into Phase II as the same time. At the very earliest this means mid to late July. Our re-opening committee is monitoring the situation and acquiring the needed supplies to meet re-opening guidelines. Pray and then pray some more! Bottom line: be patient. It will be many more weeks before we are truly able to come back together.
