However, the state has now tied Washington County's progress with Multnomah and Clackamas Counties. This means that all three counties will have to meet criteria to move into Phase II at the same time. So, at this time we are trying our best to set the plan in place to open some lower level rooms for small gatherings to come together to watch the live-stream. As soon as the downstairs bathrooms are fully functioning, we will move forward in this way. Pray and then pray some more! Bottom line: be patient.
