# ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. **Sabbath morning worship is re-opening, on a small scale, beginning September 5 from 10:50a to 12:20p.** It is a chance to come together as a community, experience the live stream worship together, see others and visit a bit before and after. It is not church as usual but it is something and it can be good! Expected guidelines will be in place to make this a safe environment. There will be a room, or maybe two, open on the lower level of the church to accommodate 20-25 people per room. Those that gather will be asked to meet the standards of in-person/indoor gatherings (masks, distance, screening, etc...). The gathering will be just before the beginning of the livestream service and will close about 90 minutes later.

If you would like to be a part of these Sabbath morning gatherings please use the Sign Up form to submit your name and the names of any family members (spouse, children) that plan to attend. Open your church app and touch the "More" button on the bottom right hand corner of your screen and then choose the "Church Worship Re-opening" option and follow the sign up instructions.

2. **Outdoor Sabbath School with Pastor Rodney** Continuing this Sabbath, August 22, 2020, from 9am to 10am, there will be an outdoor Sabbath School class, led by Pastor Rodney, that you are welcome to join. The discussions will be drawn from first, second and third books of John. This weekly Sabbath School will continue as long as the weather permits and/or until 'in person' church begins again

There are a few **IMPORTANT** items to note:

- The group will assemble behind the church, in the 'courtyard area' with 6' between family groups.
- Bring your own lawn/camping chair.
- Bring your own Bible.
- Bring your own masks.
- This will be geared towards adults. Children are welcome but you will need to have them under your care. Unfortunately, there will not be any programming for the children at this time.
- **SUPER IMPORTANT** - There will be no bathrooms available at this time. Take this into consideration.

You are invited! We are allowed to have a sizeable group as long as we are outdoors and carefully distanced. We will conclude at 10am to provide you enough time to return home to view Children's Church and the Worship livestream. Pastor Rodney will need to conclude at 10am to prepare for the livestream.

- 9. Beaverton Adventist Church App UPDATES-** If it seems that you are no longer receiving notifications from the church app it may be because you need to update the app. From time to time our app provider requires updates to keep the app working well. Be sure to go to the place you download your app and check for updates and follow the prompts to download the update.
- 10. Tech Support For Those Who Are Not Connected.** Right now our main way of connecting is by using technology. If you, or someone you know, are not able to connect to our live-streamed services, our church app or website please let us know! When we have learned about individuals who need help connecting we have been able to get them connected. We can only help if we know about it. - 11. Consider Re-Opening Church On A Personal Level.** The ability for individual church members to gather in small groups in homes and backyards is great option right for 'church' at this time. Please consider creating small group gatherings (up to 10) if you have space, such as a large living room or back yard, and if you feel comfortable with the others coming to your place. This could be on a Sabbath morning, a Sabbath afternoon, or anytime you choose. - 12. Re-Opening Church - WHEN !?! Exactly when is the big question, isn't it?** We will not be able to re-open on any meaningful level until Washington County enters Phase II of the Oregon re-opening process. However, the state has now tied Washington County's progress with Multnomah and Clackamas Counties. This means that all three counties will have to meet criteria to move into Phase II at the same time. So, at this time we are trying our best to set the plan in place to open some lower level rooms for small gatherings to come together to watch the live-stream. As soon as the downstairs bathrooms are fully functioning, we will move forward in this way. Pray and then pray some more! Bottom line: be patient.
