ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Volunteer Placement Committee Report** Thank you to all those who took a moment to vote in the Volunteer Committee Placement Report last Sabbath. It has passed with 78 votes in favor. While the report has officially been voted in, it continues to be a living document and changes may be made as necessary.
- 2. Sabbath morning worship is re-opened, on a small scale, beginning this sabbath: September 12 from 10:50a to 12:20p.** It is a chance to come together as a community, experience the live stream worship together, see others and visit a bit before and after. It is not church as usual but it is something and it can be good! Expected guidelines will be in place to make this a safe environment. There will be a room, or maybe two, open on the lower level of the church to accommodate 20-25 people per room. Those that gather will be asked to meet the standards of in-person/indoor gatherings (masks, distance, screening, etc...). The gathering will be just before the beginning of the livestream service and will close about 90 minutes later.

If you would like to be a part of these Sabbath morning gatherings please use the Sign Up form to submit your name and the names of any family members (spouse, children) that plan to attend. Open your church app and touch the "More" button on the bottom right hand corner of your screen and then choose the "Church Worship Re-opening" option and follow the sign up instructions.

- 3. Outdoor Sabbath School with Pastor Rodney** Continuing this Sabbath, Sept 12, 2020, from 9am to 10am, there will be an outdoor Sabbath School class, led by Pastor Rodney, that you are welcome to join. The discussions will be drawn from first, second and third books of John. This weekly Sabbath School will continue as long as the weather permits and/or until 'in person' church begins again. There are a few **IMPORTANT** items to note:
 - The group will assemble behind the church, in the 'courtyard area' with 6' between family groups.
 - Bring your own lawn/camping chair.
 - Bring your own Bible.
 - Bring your own masks.
 - This will be geared towards adults. Children are welcome but you will need to have them under your care. Unfortunately, there will not be any programming for the children at this time.
 - **SUPER IMPORTANT** - There will be no bathrooms available at this time. Take this into consideration.

You are invited! We are allowed to have a sizeable group as long as we are outdoors and carefully distanced. We will conclude at 10am to provide you enough time to return home to view Children's Church and the Worship livestream. Pastor Rodney will need to conclude at 10am to prepare for the livestream.

 1. All donors will be prescreened for temperature prior to entering the drive
 2. All donors will be asked to sanitize prior to entering the drive
 3. All of our staff are prescreened prior to starting work
 4. All beds and equipment will have additional sanitization steps in place between each donor
 5. Canteen table and all chairs are sanitized between donors and hand sanitizer is provided at canteen
 6. As of April 15th all American Red Cross staff, volunteers and donors are required to wear face masks
 7. Equipment is set up for social distancing

Beaverton Adventist Church App UPDATES-** If it seems that you are no longer receiving notifications from the church app it may be because you need to update the app. From time to time our app provider requires updates to keep the app working well. Be sure to go to the place you download your app and check for updates and follow the prompts to download the update.
