- 1. Church Re-Opening Updates** The Infection Control Committee has determined that, according new guidelines, we are able to include about 75 people in our sanctuary in addition to the typical worship leaders and audio-visual team members to a total of up to 97 people. However, the committee needs more time to determine when is the wisest time to move into this opportunity. There is a difference between what we can do and what we should do. We need to prayerfully and wisely get the timing right. We are just coming out of a freeze and the daily case trends are still rather high in our area significantly impacting hospital capacities. Please pray that God would direct the decision on the best timing to begin to rebuild in-person worship. When we do begin rebuilding all safety protocols need to be fully expected and willingly observed by each attendee. We will NOT be able to re-open Sabbath December 5th but expect more details soon.
