- 1. Church Re-Opening Updates** Our church 11am worship gathering is opening to in-person attendance beginning this Sabbath, December 12. The Infection Control Committee (ICC) has invested significant time over the months praying earnestly for God's leading and wisdom, discussing differing perspectives, and finally arriving at the decision to carefully re-open to the extent allowed by the state's current guidelines. The doors will open at 10:20am (Children's Church will screen at 10:30am) to allow approximately 75 attendees in the sanctuary with overflow space available if needed. We welcome you to attend according to what you discern is best for your circumstances.

Please be clear that we are expecting a high commitment, from all individuals choosing to participate in person, to respect and adhere to the current safety protocols which include proper mask wearing and distancing. We have this re-opening opportunity but recognize that the state and/or the ICC could change course if deemed necessary.
