- 7. In-Person Worship Guidelines** We appreciate the attitude of cooperation as we continue to strive to provide a Covid safe environment for church gatherings. The Covid pandemic is trending in a good direction but we are not yet beyond risk. We are fortunate that the state of Oregon extends special allowances for faith-based communities. All of us wish no restrictions or guidelines were in place but for now we must stay the course. Please remind yourself that attending worship in-person comes with certain expectations.

Review the following:

- All attendees are required to wear a proper mask, properly fitted the entire time inside the church building.
 - Clear face shields are only allowed for the upfront presenters when presenting.
 - Wear your mask even while seated.
 - Mask should cover both your mouth and nose.
 - Children 2 and under should not wear a mask.
 - Children 3 through 4 are recommended to wear a mask as long as they can remove it themselves.
 - Children 5 and older should wear mask.
 - Wash your hands with sanitizer upon entering and frequently while present.
 - Try to maintain a 6' distance from those outside your family group.
 - There will be times where we are inside this distance for a few brief moments, like passing in the hallway, but avoid sustained closeness as much as possible.
 - If you have any symptoms, such as a fever, or have knowingly been recently exposed to a Covid positive case please choose to remain home.
 - If you have specific elevated risk factors (age, underlying health conditions) prayerfully consider whether attending in-person is the right choice at this time.

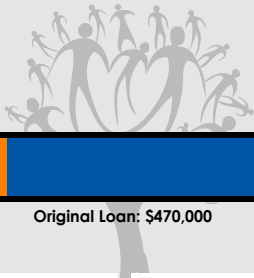
