3. **Update from the ICC Team:** On Friday, governor Brown gave us some exciting news. The vaccination rate in Oregon has been approaching an important marker. Once 70% of persons 18 and older have received one dose of a covid vaccine, most of the mask and social distancing mandates will be lifted in Oregon, including those for our church. Washington County has just recently reached that mark, and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is estimating we could reach that metric as a state by June 21. As a church, we will continue to wear masks and practice social distancing for the next two weeks, unless the mask mandate is lifted sooner. If for some reason the state's metric is not reached by then, we will begin to offer vaccination verification. Here's what it will look like: Starting June 26, if the state has not lifted the mask mandate, we will offer the following by personal choice. If you have been fully vaccinated (fully vaccinated means it has been 14 days since your final dose of the recommended vaccination schedule) and would like to have your vaccination status verified in order to remove your mask, find a designated individual and offer to share your vaccination card or a picture of your card. At that point you may remove your mask. After the mask mandate has been lifted, the CDC and OHA both recommend unvaccinated individuals continue to wear a mask and maintain appropriate social distancing. We are so grateful for our church family. Thank you for being patient. Thank you for considering others during these last 18 months. There is light at the end of this long tunnel.

4. Review the Mask Guidelines

- All attendees are required to wear a proper mask, properly fitted the entire time inside the church building.
- Clear face shields are only allowed for the upfront presenters when presenting.
- Wear your mask even while seated.
- Mask should cover both your mouth and nose.
- Children 2 and under should not wear a mask. Children 3 through 4 are recommended to wear a mask as long as they can remove it themselves.
- Children 5 and older should wear mask.
- Try to maintain a 6' distance from those outside your family group.
- There will be times where we are inside this distance for a few brief moments, like passing in the hallway, but avoid sustained closeness as much as possible.
- If you have any symptoms, such as a fever, or have knowingly been recently exposed to a Covid positive case please choose to remain home.
- If you have specific elevated risk factors (age, underlying health conditions) prayerfully consider whether attending in-person is the right choice at this time.
