- 1. - 4. Live Stream Services** This will be the last week of our current live stream schedule. Children's Church will move to 11:00a until 11:20a and is specifically designed for our children. Following that will be our main church service beginning at 11:20a with prelude music and scrolling announcements. Our shared worship service will start at 11:30a.
- 5. Enroll Your Student in Tualatin Valley Academy** TVA has begun re-enrollment for current students and will start new student enrollment on Monday, March 1, 2021.
