- 1. Oregon Mask Mandate Update The mask mandate for Oregon ended on March 11, 2022. This means we will no longer be asking our congregation to wear a mask at church. It will be an individual decision if a person wants to wear a mask or not and our church supports whichever decision is right for you and your family.
- 2. Romanian/Ukraine Refugee Offering The need is significant in Romania in order to help Ukrainian's refugees. The Adventist church in Romania has mobilized to provide as much support as they can at the border checkpoint between them and the Ukraine. We have a way to send support directly through our Beaverton Adventist brother, Cristian Butnaru. Cristian will be traveling to his home country of Romania on March 15 to join the efforts and to provide financial support.
