- Urgent prayer request for Deputy Michael Trotter and students involved in a severe accident on April 26th at Murry and TV Hwy. Deputy Trotter is Michael Colburn's best friend in WCSO. He remains in critical condition. The whole left side of his body was crushed in the accident. He will require multiple operations over the next couple of weeks repair everything. While critical but stable, he is not out of the woods by any means. He has a wife and 2 year old son. Two of the five students involved in the accident died at the scene and the others were taken to the hospital in critical condition and are, as of now, expected to survive their injuries. Prayers are needed on so many levels as this accident has immediately changed the future of 6 families. Please lift them up in prayer for healing, comfort and courage for all the family members and friends touched by this accident.
- Urgent prayer is requested for Mark Wagner. Early Sunday morning (4/24) Mark had a stroke involving a minor artery in his brain and physicians were not able to remove any clot. Mark has been left with left sided weakness. He is able to get out of bed with assistance and a walker. Please pray for Mark's full recovery from this stroke, peace and strength to meet the needs of Rehab. Pray for his family during this difficult time. May God draw close to each of them.

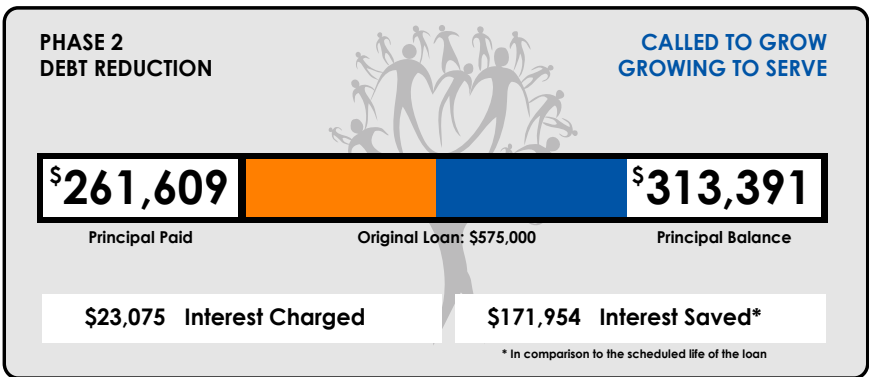
