The idea of 'One Takes' is that he tries to hit record and share his thought in only one attempt to keep things simple and authentic. They typically arrive in the church app bi-weekly on Wednesdays at 6:45p and then again on Fridays at 12:45p. If you are not getting the notification be sure to turn on notifications in the app. Just tap on the three horizontal lines in the upper left hand corner, tap 'Notifications' and then make sure the toggle is selected to show green for 'General'. Otherwise, you can also tap the 'Media' button on the center/bottom of the home screen and the entire 'One Take' archive is available.

Beaverton Adventist Church App If you would like to be in the communication loop of our local church community then you will need to get set up with the app. Please get connected by going to www.beavertonsda.com to discover guidance on the homepage or by going to your smart phone's App Store and search by typing exactly "Beaverton Adventist Church" with the quote marks. IMPORTANT NOTE: When prompted to accept notifications select 'Allow Notifications' in order to be in the flow of communication.

In particular, the General category should be enabled, others are optional.


