If you are not getting the notification be sure to turn on notifications in the app. Just tap on the three horizontal lines in the upper left hand corner, tap 'Notifications' and then make sure the toggle is selected to show green for 'General'. Otherwise, you can also tap the 'Media' button on the center/ bottom of the home screen and the entire 'One Take' archive is available.

IMPORTANT NOTE: When prompted to accept notifications select 'Allow Notifications' in order to be in the flow of communication.


