If you haven't been in the rhythm of watching them we invite you to consider doing so. The idea of 'One Takes' is that he tries to hit record and share his thought in only one attempt to keep things simple and authentic. They typically arrive in the church app bi-weekly on Wednesdays at 6:45p and then again on Fridays at 12:45p. If you are not getting the notification be sure to turn on notifications in the app. Just tap on the three horizontal lines in the upper left hand corner, tap 'Notifications' and then make sure the toggle is selected to show green for 'General'. Otherwise, you can also tap the 'Media' button on the center/ bottom of the home screen and the entire 'One Take' archive is available.
- **16. Beaverton Adventist Church App UPDATES-** If it seems that you are no longer receiving notifications from the church app, go to the "hamburger" icon (upper left) and select Settings > Notifications and check that the desired notification categories are enabled. In particular, the General category should be enabled, others are optional.


