Snapshot of church finances as of January 24, 2024

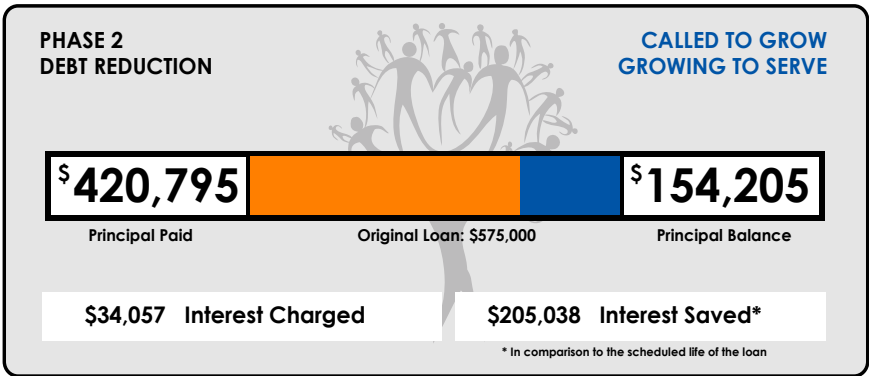
