Snapshot of church finances as of January 31, 2024

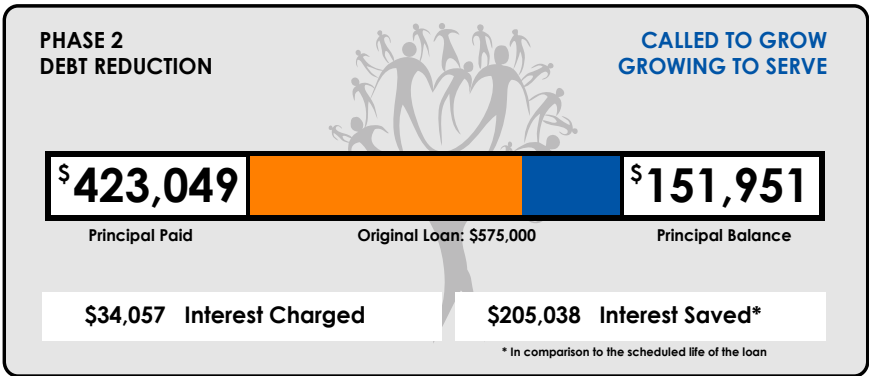
