Snapshot of church finances as of March 5, 2024

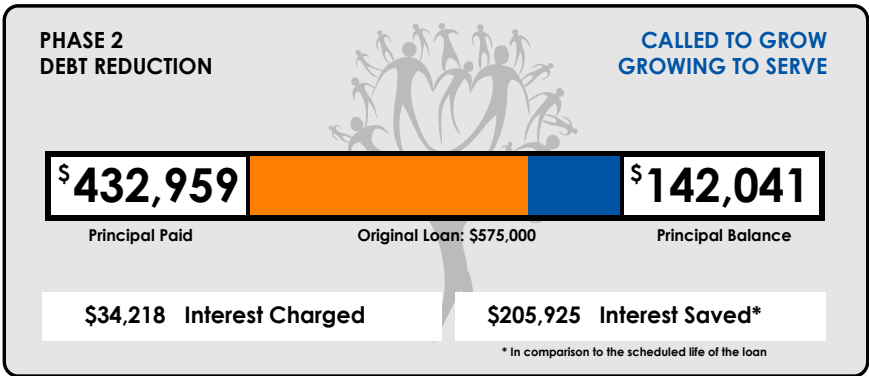
