Snapshot of church finances as of March 13, 2024

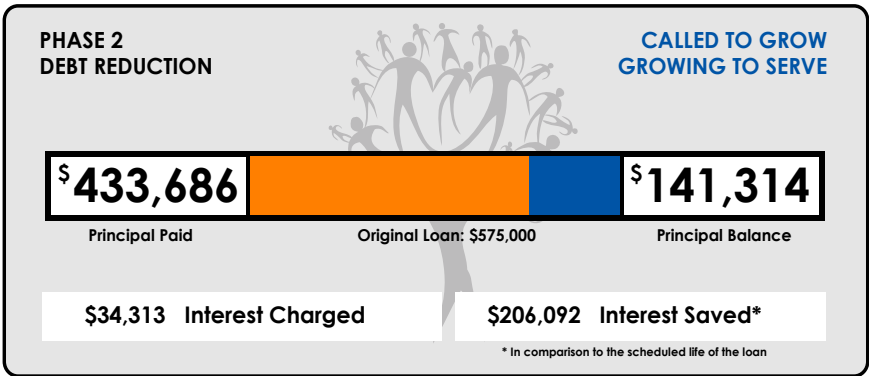
