Snapshot of church finances as of March 27, 2024

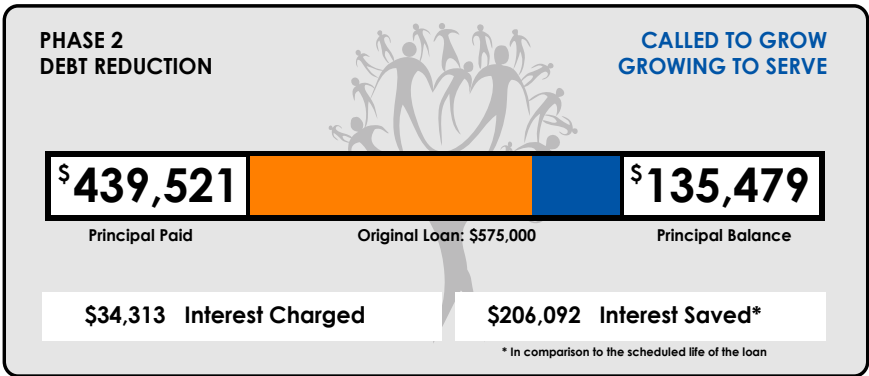
