Snapshot of church finances as of March 31, 2024

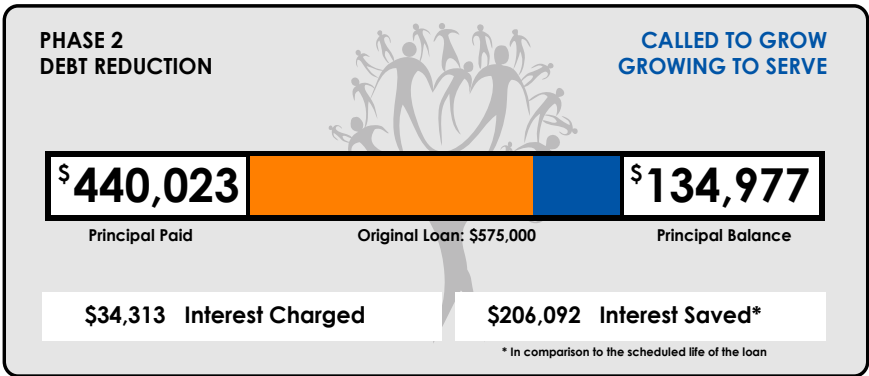
