Snapshot of church finances as of April 17, 2024

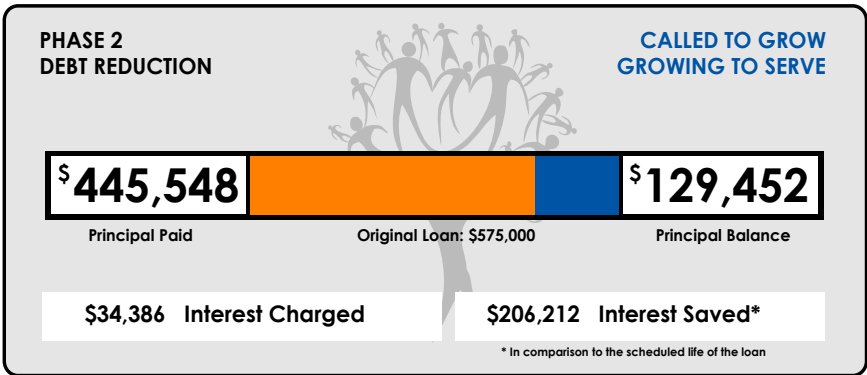
