Snapshot of church finances as of April 24, 2024

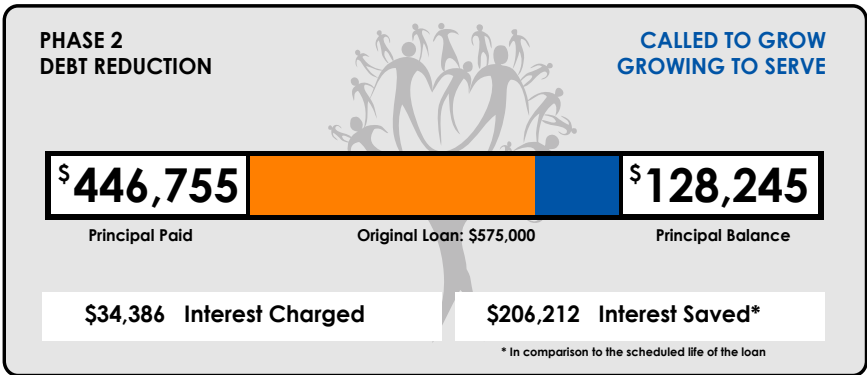
