Snapshot of church finances as of May 8, 2024

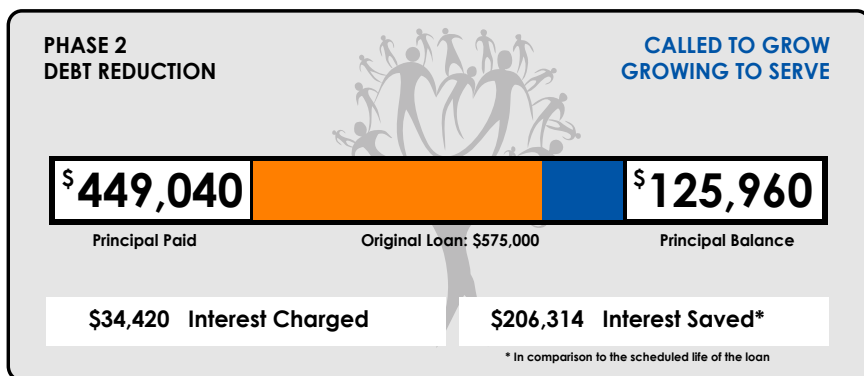
