Snapshot of church finances as of May 15 , 2024

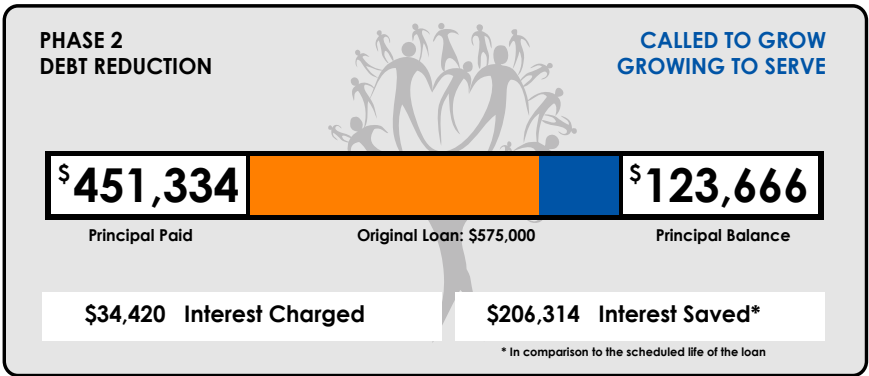
