Snapshot of church finances as of May 22, 2024

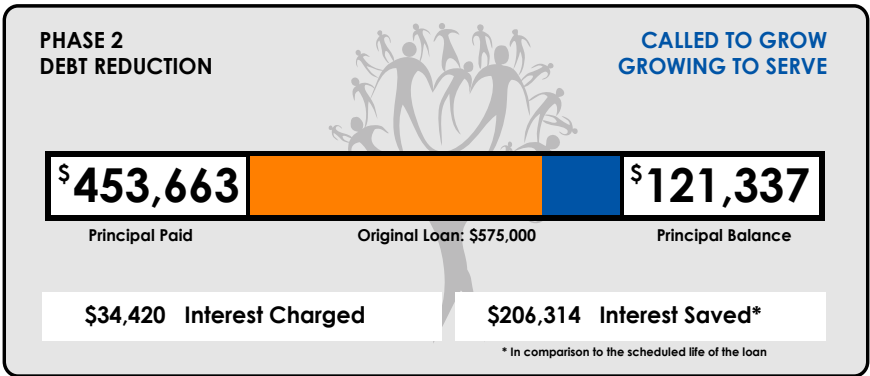
