Snapshot of church finances as of June 12, 2024

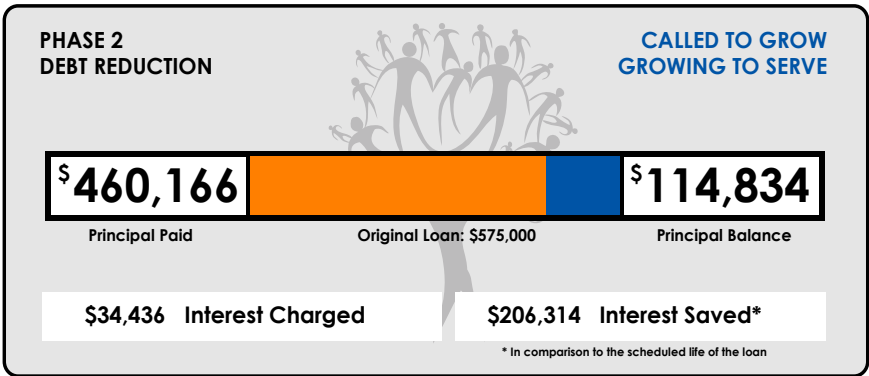
