Snapshot of church finances as of June 19, 2024

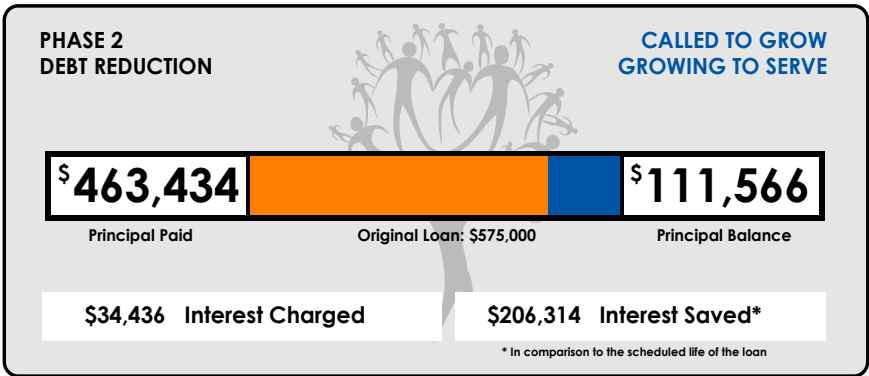
