Snapshot of church finances as of July 24, 2024

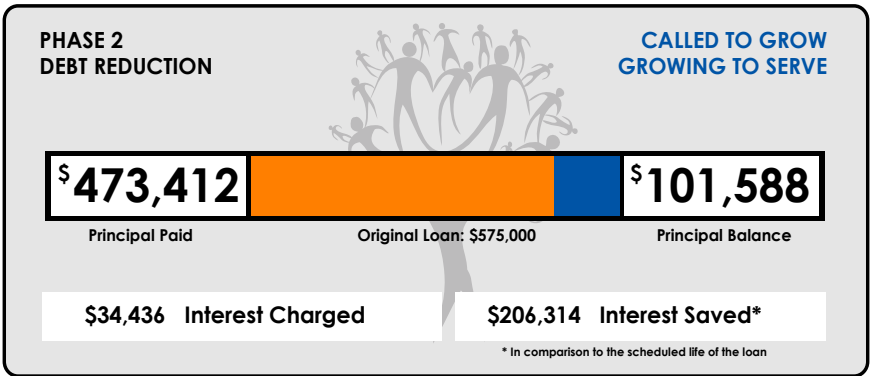
