Snapshot of church finances as of September 18, 2024

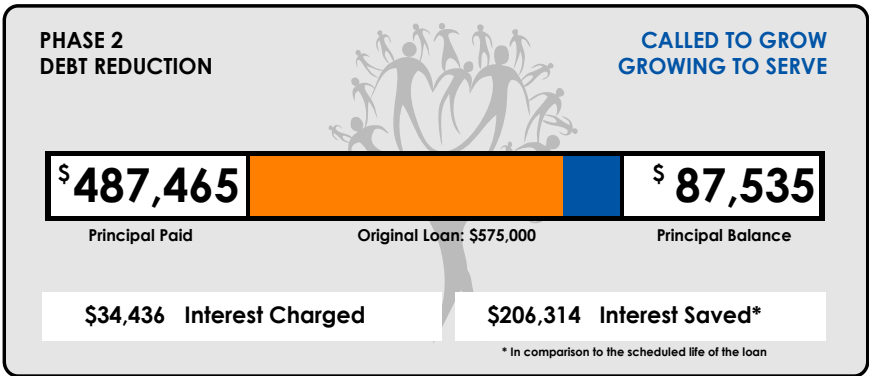
