Snapshot of church finances as of September 25, 2024

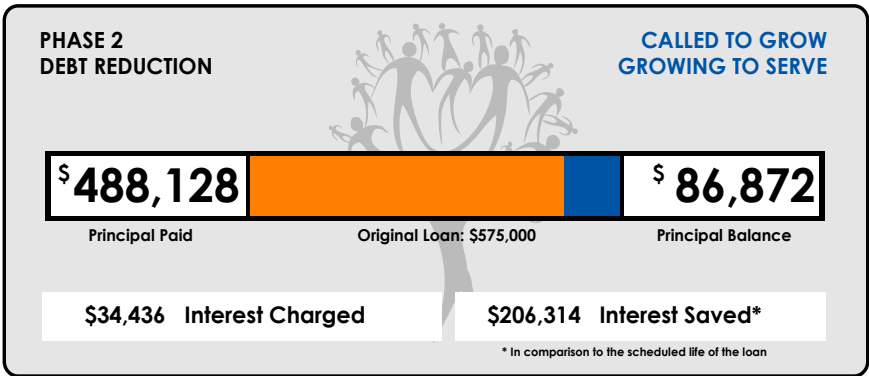
